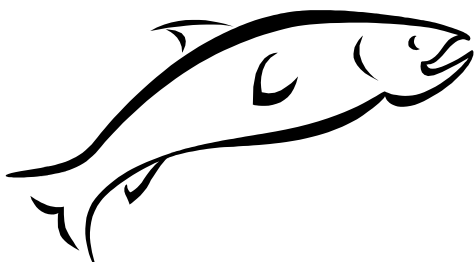
Which of these two animals is a mammal? Circle it.
