



## Zoo Camp Drop-Off and Pick-Up Information Preschool Week-Long Classes

Please allow extra time to find your way on the first day of camp as the drop-off/pick-up location is NOT the main Zoo entrance.

### **Main Drop-Off/Pick-Up Location: East Entrance Directions**

Upon entering the Zoo from McAndrews Road (also known as County Road 38) turn RIGHT at the stop sign and follow the signs for Zoo Camp. Our drop-off location will be located at the white tents in the area between the two East parking lots (Toucan and Tiger).

*Sign In/Sign Out:* On Monday, please park in the parking lot and walk your child to the drop off area to meet their instructor. You will be asked to sign in your child on Monday and list and/or approve the adults authorized to pick up your child. From Tuesday–Friday, you may park your car and drop off your child with their teacher at the designated drop-off location – no sign in will be required. You must, however, still park and sign out your child each day. Photo ID is required to sign out campers. Please note: on Thursday and Friday, the East entrance may be open to the general public. This may cause an increase in traffic during some drop off and pick up times. Please identify yourself as a Zoo Camp participant to any Zoo staff directing traffic.

**Zoo Camp Times:** Please arrive promptly during drop-off and pick-up.

**Drop-Off:** 9:30 AM for morning classes  
1:00 PM for afternoon classes

**Pick-Up:** 12:00 PM for morning classes  
3:30 PM for afternoon classes

Please **be on time** so the whole group isn't kept waiting.

- T-shirts:** Week-long campers will receive one t-shirt included with their registration and may also purchase additional t-shirts from their instructor for \$12.00 each if they wish. Children and adult sizes are available.
- Backpack:** Please have your child bring either a backpack or a brown paper grocery bag (with their name written on it) to class. It will be used to carry home papers or art projects.
- Water bottle:** Please have your child bring a water bottle (with their name written on it) for drinking water throughout their time at the Zoo.
