MAKING OUR VOICES HEARD AND SEEING RESULTS

During the 2010 legislative session, the **Minnesota Zoo secured \$21 million in state funding**. As a result, construction is underway on the ambitious and exciting Heart of the Zoo project, as well as much-needed maintenance and other improvements to existing exhibits and facilities. Our operations funding also fared as well as could be expected.

The *Minnesotans for a Great Zoo* grassroots network, played an important role in securing this state support. You were actively involved in contacting elected officials, communicating the Zoo's importance in the state and asking for their continued support.

HOW YOU CAN HELP

This fall, Minnesotans will elect a new governor, and all state legislators will face elections. With more demands on state and private resources, **the Minnesota Zoo needs continued strong support from state elected officials.**

 - *Generates significant tourism, has an economic impact of about \$114 million annually and improves our quality of life.*
 - *Offers unmatched education opportunities such as the Zoomobile, WolfQuest and Zoo Safari, and provides lifelong learning to all Minnesotans.*
 - *Leads important conservation initiatives to protect our world, including Minnesota wildlife such as trumpeter swans and moose.*

✓ **Tell them why you support the Minnesota Zoo.**

✓ **Above all, ask them to support the Minnesota Zoo's operating budget and future capital investments.**
